- the **Union of Portuguese Municipalities CIM do AVE**, composed of 8 member Municipalities and engaged in local and regional development;
- the **Municipality of Cuenca**, the provincial capital of one of the 5 provinces of Castile-La Mancha autonomous community of Spain;
- the **Conca D'Oro Sports Club** of Palermo, engaged in activities related to the promotion of sport with projects to raise awareness of sport in schools.

The objective of this partnership is to improve the knowledge and practices related to sports and the promotion of sports in favor of students and young people, favoring greater cohesion and collaboration between **Sports Clubs, Municipalities and Schools**.
